



Private Pilot Ground School Assistance Program Application

The Michigan Association of Airport Executives (MAAE) is a professional association of airport management professionals providing wide-ranging services to airport and aviation professionals located throughout Michigan. MAAE is offering financial assistance to high school students interested in completing the ground school training required to becoming a private pilot. This program will provide up to \$250 for each selected applicant.

Guidelines for this reimbursement program are as follows:

- Candidate must be a high school student 14-18 years of age at the time of application.
- Include a short essay (approximately 200 words) describing your interest in obtaining ground school training.
- Completion of a training course that provides an endorsement to take the private pilot written test is required (ground school should be endorsed by a licensed Michigan flight school).
- Application must be submitted by May 20, 2020 prior to enrolling in ground school training.
- Certificate of completion must be signed by a Michigan-based flight instructor and a copy emailed to MAAE before September 1, 2020, to the address listed below.
- Selected applicant will receive funds after submitting documentation verifying successful completion of training.
